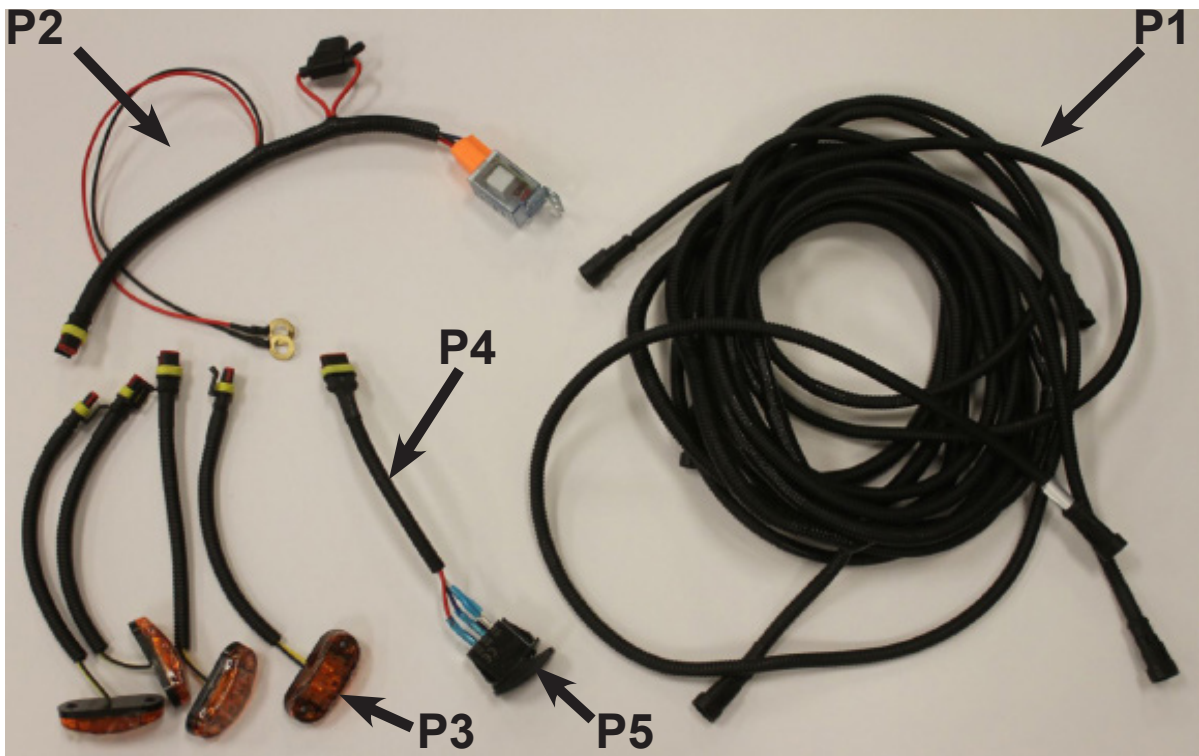

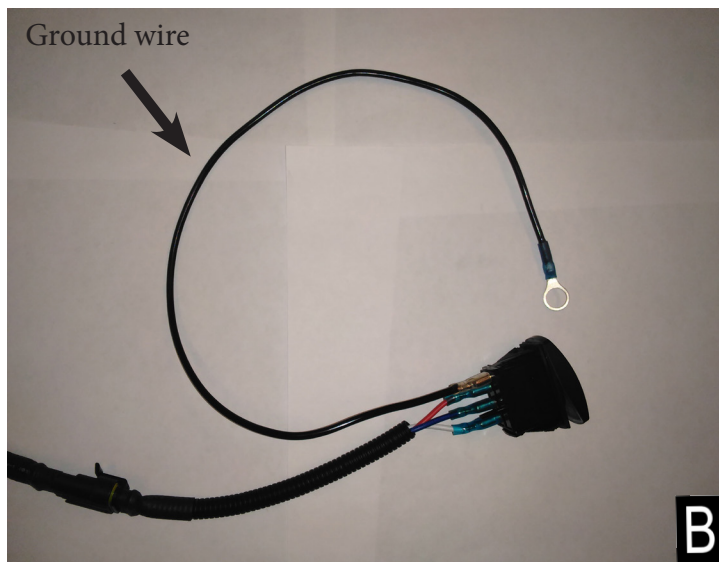
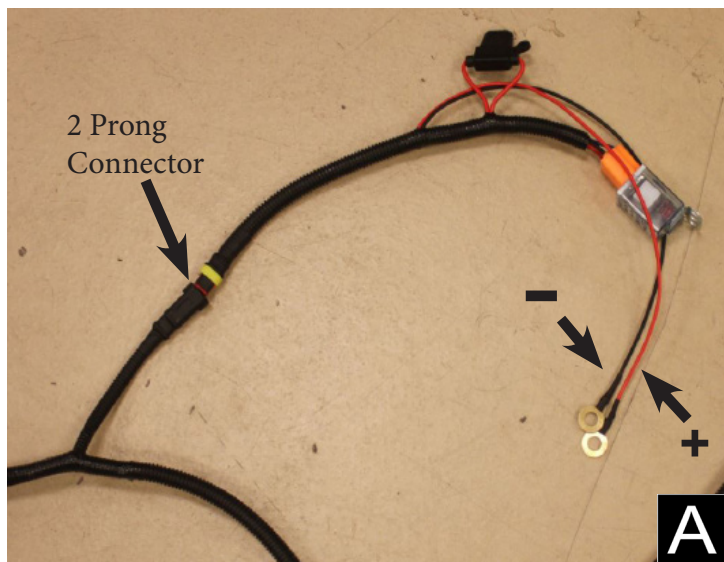


Step 1: Place vehicle on a flat and level surface. Place gear selector in "Park" and remove keys from the ignition.

Step 2: Locate power source, connect (P2) wires to source and connect (P2) to wire harness (P1). For protection the wire harness has a 30 amp fuse provided. (Figure A).

Step 3: Locate desired location for wire harness and run the Y-Ends to the front, and rear of the vehicle.

Note: If the battery is in the front end of the vehicle, run the short end to the front of the vehicle. If the battery is located towards the back end, run the short end to the rear of the vehicle.



Step 4: Install the rocker switch provided and route the wiring to the locations for mounting your lights. Make sure the rocker switch is grounded properly on the frame or negative side of the power bar. (Figure B).

Step 5: Drill a hole for each light using .68" bit for the light. Rotate the light the direction you want and screw in place with the self tapping screws provided. Do not over tighten. Over tightening will cause the screws to strip. (Figure C).

This completes installation. Time to ride and enjoy!



ProTip: Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten if needed.
